Jeremiah 31:3

I have loved you, my people, with an everlasting love. With unfailing love I have drawn you to myself.

Exodus 34:6-7

Yahweh! The Lord! The God of compassion and mercy! I am slow to anger and filled with unfailing love and faithfulness. I lavish unfailing love to a thousand generations. I forgive iniquity, rebellion, and sin.

Psalms 145:8

The Lord is merciful and
compassionate, slow to
get angry and filled with
unfailing love.

1 John 4:8-10

God is love. God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

John 16:27

The Father himself loves
you dearly because you
love me and believe that I
came from God.

1 Corinthians 1:9

God will do this, for he is faithful to do what he says, and he has invited you into partnership with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

Psalms 103:17

But the love of the Lord
remains forever with
those who fear him. His
salvation extends to the
children's children.

Hosea 2:19-20

I will make you my (spouse)
forever, showing you
righteousness and justice,
unfailing love and compassion. I
will be faithful to you and make
you mine, and you will finally
know me as the Lord.

Ephesians 2:4-5

But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, 5 that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead.

(It is only by God's grace that you have been saved!)

James 5:11

We give great honor to those who endure under suffering. For instance, you know about Job, a man of great endurance. You can see how the Lord was kind to him at the end, **for the Lord is full of tenderness and mercy.**

Isaiah 55:6-7

Seek the Lord while you can find him. Call on him now while **he is near**. Let the wicked change their ways and banish the very thought of doing wrong. Let them turn to the Lord that he may have mercy on them. Yes, turn to our God, for **he will forgive generously**.

Titus 3:4-7

When God our Savior revealed his kindness and love, he saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit. He generously poured out the Spirit upon us through Jesus Christ our Savior. Because of his grace he made us right in his sight and gave us confidence that we will inherit eternal life.

Deuteronomy 4:31

For the Lord your God is
a merciful God; he will
not abandon you or
destroy you or forget the
solemn covenant he made
with your ancestors.

Psalms 145:18

**The Lord is close to all
who call on him,
yes, to all who call on
him in truth.**
